From the Vice Chancellor's Desk

Warm Greetings to all



As the seventy-fifth Independence Day approaches, Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav continues with an increased patriotic fervour. Programmes are being organized with emphasis on curricular, cocurricular and extracurricular activities. The University had the honour and privilege of hosting an in depth discussion on the book Modi @ 20: Dreams meet Delivery at which the Hon'ble Union Minister of State, Ministry of Education, Government of India, Smt. Annapurna Devi was the Chief Guest, and former Chairman, ISRO, Shri A.S.Kiran Kumar and Vice Chairperson Apollo Hospitals, Ms Shobhana Kamineni were the Guests of Honour. As the Chief Guest rightly observed, "the Prime Minister's twenty year long journey so far, first as the Chief Minister of Gujarat and then as the Prime Minister of India is a study of how he utilized his experience as a common man to bring to focus the governance's orientation for the betterment of its people". Another significant event was the workshop on the National Education Policy 2020, a testimony to the commitment of the University toward the frame work laid down by the UGC.

The visit to Chitkara University, Chandigarh, Punjab by a team of two faculty and ten students as part of Ek Bharat Sreshta Bharat has empowered the group with knowledge and ideas on various topics. The information gained is soon to be incorporated in action at the Central University also where it is deemed that it will be of use to the students and the institute.

The Independence Day celebrations began officially from 1 August 2022. All faculty and staff were part of the various programs organized including a team of student coordinators to assist them in effective and

smooth conduct of the events. The events comprised of various sports, essay writing competitions, drawing/painting competitions etc. Prabhat Pheri and Har Ghar Tiranga were also organised and both students and faculty enthusiastically participated in these events.

The Independence Day celebrations alone were a visual feast. The march past was performed by three groups of students clad in the colours of the flag and led by the Bharat Mata. The rich diversity of the students from various parts of India was displayed in the various cultural performances performed on the occasion. All students and faculty irrespective of state, language, culture and religion celebrated the occasion with great joy and enthusiasm. In spite of the celebrations and activities and the very busy schedule, academics were given their due importance in the second semester postgraduate and undergraduate students writing their semester end examinations. Entrance exam for DACE was conducted and the results of the students who got through was published on 2 September. It is a matter of pride for the University that 94 students have been admitted on merit basis.

I am proud to state that within an extremely short period since it's inception, the university is functioning on par with other premier Central Universities in implementing all the UGC and central government programmes issued for higher education institutes. Workshop on 'Internalization and Institutionalization of National Education Policy 2020: Role and Responsibility of the Teacher'



A Workshop on 'Internalization and Institutionalization of National Education Policy 2020: Role and Responsibility of the Teacher' was organized by the University at Transit Campus I on 2 July. Ms O.Panathi welcomed the guests Dr Rajendra Joshi, CESS, Bangalore and Ms B.S. Padmavathi, CESS Bangalore after which Dean in-charge Prof.G.Ram Reddy gave the welcome address. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. S A Kori elaborated on how the University is taking appropriate measures to implement the NEP 2020.

Prof. V.V.N.Rajendra Prasad, Distinguished faculty of CUAP spoke on the occassion mentioning that the Guru-Shishya bond between a student and teacher is an academic one as well as an emotional one. He stated that the ancient Indian education system had focused on individual skills and abilities, and the same is being insisted upon by the NEP. Prof. Rajendra Joshi also focused his lecture on the pedagogy and teacher qualities which are responsible for institutional improvement. Ms. B.S.Padmavati



gave her talk on how the Government of India took adequate measures to promote research and bring into action the NEP 2020. In the post lunch session, there was an interactive session where the faculty were divided into groups to identify individual and institutional gaps in implementing the NEP and they brainstormed to identify ways to bridge these gaps.

The Central University of Andhra Pradesh hosted an event to discuss the book *Modi* @ 20: Dreams meet Delivery on 4 August 2022. The Hon'ble Union Minister of State, Smt. Annapurna Devi was the Chief Guest and former Chairman, ISRO Shri A.S.Kiran Kumar and Ms. Shobhana Kamineni, Vice Chairperson Apollo Hospitals, were the guests of honour. The programme started with the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor welcoming the guess. He elaborated



on the various programmes offered by the university and the developments happening in both academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular areas. Ms Shobhana Kamineni gave her speech on how the Government of India is placing much emphasis on development of women through various policies formulated for the betterment of women, and how the GDP of India has crossed the expectation. Teachers' Day


