ABOUT THE SEMINAR

India, as the world's largest democracy, has sustained a robust electoral process despite lacking many presumed prerequisites outlined by Western scholars. Indian elections, often held in a festive spirit, have intrigued researchers to focus on the evolving strategies and voter engagement that lead to increased turnouts despite socio-economic disparities. Amongst such identified proclivities, a key trend shaping electoral politics is the rerise of welfare politics, which gained momentum in post-2000, influencing national and state-level strategies across all parties. This has led to a phenomenon of "competitive populism", where welfare promises dominate campaigns, raising debates on the fine line distinction between welfarist, neo-populist, and freebie politics. To explore these evolving politicoelectoral dynamics, a national seminar is being organized aiming at providing a platform for students, scholars, and faculty to analyze and document the impact of this neo-phenomenal welfare politics in Indian democracy and its role in shaping politico-policy regimes.

Objectives of the Seminar

- To analyze the historical evolution and changing dimensions of welfare politics in India
- To examine the conceptual distinction between populism, welfarism, and freebie-ism in Indian political discourse
- To evaluate the economic sustainability and fiscal implications of welfare programs in India
- To assess the role of welfare policies in social justice and reducing promoting inequalities
- To discuss the legal and constitutional implications of freebie politics in India
- To measure the impact of such policies on democratic depth in the Indian politico-popular landscape.

THEMES

The seminar aims to provide a platform to unshackle debates on India's 'Neo' Politics centered on populism, welfarism, and freebie-ism with the main intent to foster a deeper understanding of how freebie politics influences democratic processes. The seminar will augment the awareness among students, research scholars, and other stakeholders about the long-term consequences of freebie politics on governance, economic growth, and social welfare in myriad ways. It will shed light on the legal and constitutional underpinnings of welfare politics and freebies.

- The paper should be original and not previously published or under consideration elsewhere. It should be between 3000-5000 words in length (including references, tables, and figures). The full paper should be submitted as per the APA 7th edition.
- The abstract and full paper must be submitted in MS Word format, with all pages numbered.
- Formatting guidelines include using Times New Roman Font, 12-point font size, single spacing, 1-inch margins, and consecutively numbered tables with appropriate titles using Arabic numerals.
- · A team of experts will review all the papers, and selected papers will be published in an edited book with ISBN.
